

On receipt of your new ASM Canterbury Raised Toilet Frame please check the contents for signs of damage, report any defects to **ASM Medicare Ltd** immediately. The Canterbury comes fully assembled and ready for use.

The Canterbury is height adjustable, to adjust please follow the instructions below.

- 1) Lay the frame on it's side and remove the plastic clips from 2 legs. See Fig 1.
- 2} Slide the internal legs to the required position ensuring that both legs are adjusted equally.
- 3) Replace the plastic clips, you may have to twist the leg slightly to allow the steel pin to locate completely, it is "Essential" that the clips are fully engaged to avoid injury.
 - 4} Turn the frame over and repeat for the other 2 remaining legs.
 - 5} Place the frame back on it's feet on a level surface and check that it is stable and does not rock, if it does, readjust until it is stable.
 - 6} Periodic checks of *all* screws and fittings is recommended, replace if required.
- 7} Clean the Canterbury frame by using a mild proprietary soap and / or disinfectant. The plastic sleeve is also removable for ease of cleaning, it simply lifts out. Dry with a soft clean cloth.

The intended use of this product is to provide the user with a height adjustable toilet seat, which can be used over an existing toilet without modification. M.U.W = 152 kg / 24 st.
